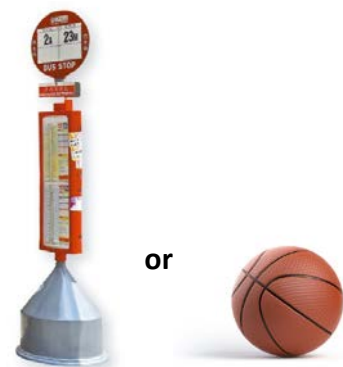
3. Learning English through Social Issues
